2.The petitioner had given a complaint before the second respondent. She had been summoned for enquiry and she has been asked to appear again tomorrow.

3.The second respondent is directed to conclude the enquiry on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks. If at the end of the enquiry, the second respondent comes to the conclusion that cognizable offences are made out then FIR shall be registered as per law. If the second respondent comes to the conclusion that no case made out, then the closure report should be served on the petitioner without any delay so that the petitioner can avail other remedies available to her under law.



4. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of.
