3.In view of the above, this Criminal Original Petition is devoid of merits and the same is dismissed.

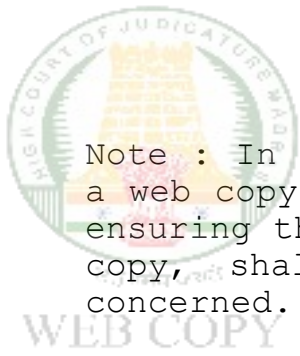
