PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.502/2022 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 341, 294(b), 324 and 307 of IPC, in Crime No.502 of 2022, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 31.08.2022, due to the property dispute, the petitioners abused the defacto complainant in filthy language, assaulted him with aruval and also threatened him with dire consequences. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that due to previous enmity, the present complaint has been lodged against the petitioners and it is a civil dispute, which has been given criminal colour. He would further submit that they did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution and they are innocent persons.



4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) would submit that the injured is not yet discharged from the hospital and the investigation is still pending.

5.Considering the gravity of offence committed by the petitioners and also considering the fact that the injured is still in hospital, this Court is not inclined to anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
