The prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents 1 to 4 to remove the encroachment made by the fifth respondent on the main road near Arulmigu Shree Kulandhai Velappar Murugan Temple in Survey No.490, Poomparai Main Road, Poomparai, Kodaikanal Taluk, Dindigul District.

2. The grievance of the petitioner is that though he made a representation to the official respondents as early as on 18.04.2018 seeking removal of the encroachment made by the fifth respondent, till date, the same has not been removed.
