**Prayer** : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records of the second respondent relating to the orders in Letter No.59708/CMPC/2012-1, Finance (CNPC) Department dated 18.01.2013, to quash the same and to issue consequential directions to the respondents to fix the scale of pay of the petitioners 1 to 7 and 9 and that of the husband of eighth petitioner in the post of Assistant Driller in Ground Water Division in Public Works Department, at Rs.1400-2300 with effect from 01.06.1988 and at Rs.5000-6000 with effect from 01.01.1996 and to grant consequential monetary benefits of arrears of pay with 12% Compound Interest per annum.
