2.Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

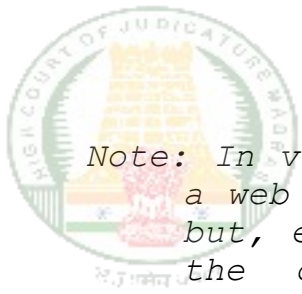
