However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to give a fresh representation in the light of the applicable circular within a period of two (2) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On receipt of the said representation, the first respondent shall consider the same on merits and in accordance with law. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition stands closed
