PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 1st respondent to register the partition deed dated 20.03.2001 which is pending for registration vide P.No.20 of 2003 before the 1st respondent and to return the original document of partition deed dated 20.03.2001 to the petitioner after due registration if necessary, by making appropriate endorsements to collect the necessary deficit stamp duty and any other charges depending upon the outcome of W.P.N.25719 of 2003.

ORDER

The present writ petition has been filed seeking a writ of Mandamus, directing to register a partition deed, dated 20.03.2001, which is pending for registration vide P.No.20 of 2003 on the file of the first respondent herein.

2. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the demand of an enhanced stamp duty made by the first respondent herein was challenged before the second respondent. The second respondent had passed an order confirming such a demand. The said order of the second respondent was challenged by way of a revision before the third respondent. The third respondent has also confirmed the same. The said order was challenged in W.P(MD)No.25719 of 2003 before the Principal Bench, which was dismissed recently.



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3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, he has proposed to file a writ appeal before the Principal Bench. Without prejudice to the contentions of the writ petitioner in the said writ appeal, the present Writ Petition is closed. No costs.
