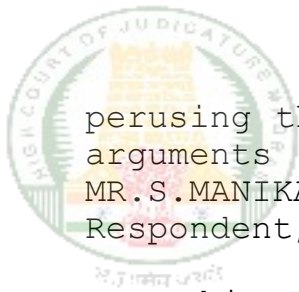
PRAYER IN CRL MP(MD)No. 6556 of 2022:
