PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.91/2022 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Section 379 IPC r/w. 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 in Cr.No.91 of 2022, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that petitioner has transported one unit of Red sand illegally by using Tipper Lorry. Hence, the complaint.



3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and his name has been falsely implicated in this case.

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4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) would submit that the petitioner has illegally transported one unit of Red sand worth about Rs.5,000/- and the same has been recovered. He would further submit that investigation of the case is pending and strongly opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the property has been recovered, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manaparai, Trichy District, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a) the petitioner is directed to pay a sum of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one Thousand only) to the Annai Sathiya Ammaiyyar Memorial Government Children Home (Dr. Thangaraj Colony, K.K. Nagar, Madurai - 625 020, **(Account No:-37487255860, IFSC Code:- SBIN0007922, State Bank of India, Madurai)** without prejudice to his rights and contentions before the trial Court and produce the receipt/acknowledgment before the concerned Court while executing sureties;

(b) the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(c) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am until further orders.

(d) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(e) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(f) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action



against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**; and;

(g)if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
