Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to conduct fresh auction in connection with the collection of Undiyal from the vendors of the weekly market, Kalaiyarkovil, Sivagangai District by inviting tenders and wide paper publication within a time stipulated by this Court.

ORDER

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner took away a file in the year 2019 along with the change of vakalat. It appears that the writ petition has been filed only for a writ of Mandamus to direct the respondents to conduct a fresh auction in collection of the Hundial from the vendors of the weekly market, Kalaiyarkovil, Sivagangai District, by inviting tenders and wide paper publication within a time stipulated period. There was a stay granted in favour of the petitioner.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has engaged a new counsel after taking the papers back from the counsel who was engaged originally but has not filed a fresh vakalat of the new counsel, I am inclined to vacate the stay and dismiss the writ petition for non-prosecution. No costs. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
