PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 23.09.2022 and to grant permission on the basis of the petitioner's representation to conduct Adal Padal programme on 01.10.2022 in Mutharamman Kalaiarangam at Thiruvalluvar Nagar, Umarikadu Post, Korkai, Thoothukudi District.

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ORDER

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This writ petitioner filed this Writ Petition seeking for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 23.09.2022 and to grant permission on the basis of the petitioner's representation to conduct Adal Padal programme on 01.10.2022 in Mutharamman Kalaiarangam at Thiruvalluvar Nagar, Umarikadu Post, Korkai, Thoothukudi District.

2.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that temple Festival for the temple, by name, 'Arulmigu Agalwari Swami Kovil', at Thiruvalluvar Nagar, Umarikadu Post, Korkai, Thoothukudi District, is going to be held on 01.10.2022. Subsequent to the same, in order to conduct a cultural programme, the petitioner sought permission of the police by giving a representation dated **23.09.2022**. But, the third respondent has not considered the said representation. Since no order



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was passed, the petitioner has come before this Court for the above said relief.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that the third respondent has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

5. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (criminal side) appearing for the respondent police.

6. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai had issued a circular memorandum in Rc. 007301/Genl.I (1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated **23.09.2022** and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular, immediately.
