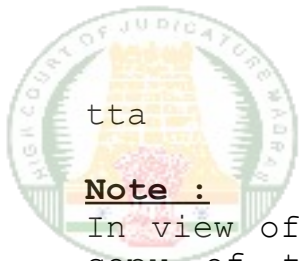
3.Recording the aforesaid submission made on behalf of the petitioners, this contempt petition is closed.
