PRAYER: Contempt Petition filed under Section 11 of Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, to punish the respondent for the willful and deliberate disobedience to the orders of this Court made in W.P.(MD) No.7509 of 2021, dated 01.04.2021.

Prayer in WP(MD). 7509/ 2021 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court S-12.To issue appropriate Writs , orders or directions and in particular issue a writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to pay the petitioner interest at the rate of 18 percentage per annum, for the period of delay from 01/06/2017 to 04/12/2017 and for the period of delay from 01/06/2017 to 02/01/2017 and also for the period of delay from 01/06/2017 to 10/01/2017 , in paying the amounts paid towards the petitioners terminal benefits namely EPF Employees Contribution, Gratuity and Encashment of Earned / Sick Leaves within a time frame as may be fixed by this Honble Court and without affecting his right to claim balance amounts towards those benefits and thus render justice.
