PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.186/2022 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Sole Accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Section 9(B)(1)(a) of Indian Explosive Act, in Crime No.186 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was found in possession of white thread, which is used for making crackers without proper permission. Therefore, the present case came to be registered.

3.This the second anticipatory bail application. Earlier anticipatory bail application filed by the petitioner in Crl.OP(MD) No.11903 of 2022 was dismissed by this Court on 02.08.2022, on the ground that the petitioner is having previous cases, which are

5.Considering the nature of offence, the petitioner is not entitled for claiming discretionary relief of anticipatory bail.
