PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

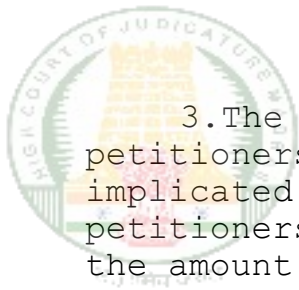
PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 101 of 2022 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/ accused Nos. 3 and 4, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 8(c), 20(b)(ii)(B) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, in Crime No.101 of 2022, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners were found in illegal possession of 1.500 Kgs of Ganja. Hence, the complaint.



3.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case. However, he would further submit that the petitioners, without prejudice to their rights, are ready to deposit the amount that may be imposed by this Court.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that 14 previous cases are pending against the first petitioner and one previous case is pending against the second petitioner.

5.Considering the above and also the nature of the charges levelled against the petitioners and also considering the antecedents of the petitioners, this Court is inclined to anticipatory grant bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Principal Special District Court, (for EC & NDPS Cases), Madurai, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of **Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) each**, with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a) the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

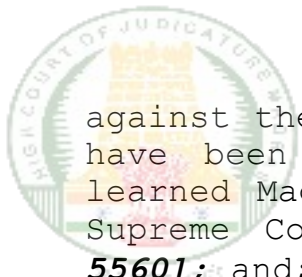
[b] the first petitioner shall pay a sum of **Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand only) to the credit of District Siddha Medical Officer CCRIPKM (Account No:-10767823177, IFSC Code:-SBIN0000898, State Bank of India, Periyakulam Branch)**, within a period of two weeks without prejudice to their rights and contentions before the trial Court. The petitioners shall execute the sureties on showing the receipt of the said amount.

(c) the petitioners shall report before the respondent police **once in a week i.e., on every Sunday at 10.30 a.m.**, for a period of Eight weeks, and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.

(d)the petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(e)the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(f)on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action



against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**; and;

(g)if the accused / petitioners thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
