PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.2/2021 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 408, 409, 120(B) of I.P.C., in Crime No. 2 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and the first accused are the officers in Co-operative Society and they have misappropriated the fund of Society to the tune of Rs.2,03,700.

4.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and she has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

5.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that this is the second application of the petitioner and after conducting enquiry, it was revealed that



the accused had committed misappropriation and opposed to anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the nature of offence and the quantum of amount involved in this petition, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
