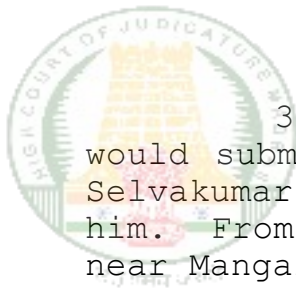

3. Upon instructions, learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the alleged detenu has got acquaintance with one Selvakumar S/o.Palanichamy, through instagram and she eloped with him. From the call details, it is gathered that they were somewhere near Mangalore.
