3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor as well as the counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner on 02.10.2022, the petitioner was arrested and remanded in judicial custody in respect of some other case.

4.In view of the submission made by the counsel on either side, there is no question as to the relaxation of the condition at this stage. After obtaining the bail order in the above case, the petitioner can revive the present application for relaxation.

5.This criminal miscellaneous petition is dismissed accordingly.
