ORDER

None appears for the petitioner. What is under challenge in this writ petition is show cause notice proposing the petitioner's disqualification under the Tamil Nadu Cooperative Societies Act. As rightly pointed out by the learned Government Counsel, at the stage of show cause notice, there will be little scope for interference. It cannot be case of the petitioner that the second respondent without jurisdiction issued the notice in question. However, it appears that the proceedings had not attained finality till date. Hence, the second respondent may send one more intimation to the petitioner and thereby proceed in accordance with law.



2. With this direction to the second respondent, the writ petition is dismissed. No costs. Connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
