PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

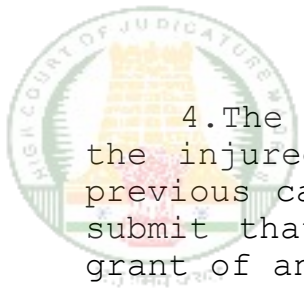
PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.292 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 342, 324, 294(b) and 506(ii) of IPC, in Crime No.292 of 2022, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to previous motive, the petitioners and other accused attacked the defacto complainant with stick and abused him in filthy language. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that the petitioner shall abide any condition imposed by this Court and he may be granted anticipatory bail.



4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) would submit that the injured has already been discharged from the hospital and no previous case is pending against the petitioners. He would further submit that investigation is still pending. Hence, he opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

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5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the facts that the injured has already been discharged from the hospital and the petitioners are not having any bad antecedents, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Vilathikulam, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a)the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b)the second and third petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders and the first petitioner shall report before the respondent police once in a week on every Monday at 10.30 a.m until further orders.

(c)the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d)the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e)on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**; and;

(f)if the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
