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PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records relating to the impugned order No. SA/XP.677/WID/Cons/VCA/17 dated 03.04.2017 issued by the third respondent and quash the same as arbitrary, illegal, malafide and against the provisions of Railway Protection Force Act 1957 and its Rules 1987 and Directive No. 32 issued by the first respondent and to consequently direct the third respondent to retain the petitioner at Karur post till completion of my tenure of 5 years as per Directive No.32 issued by the first respondent
