The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw this criminal original petition. Leave granted. This petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

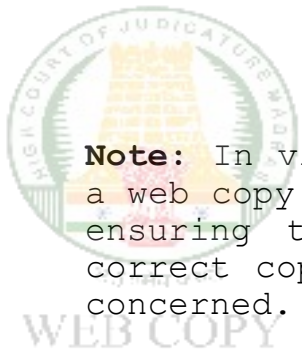
