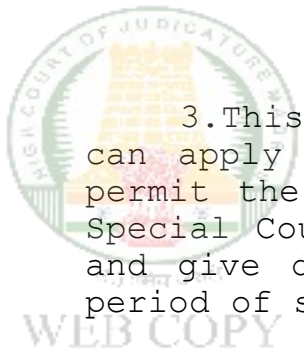

ORDER

2.The petitioner wants removal of attachment made over the petition mentioned properties. The petitioner's counsel submitted that since he is not a party to the proceedings, he will not have *locus standi* to move the Special Court.



3.This contention is without any basis. Any aggrieved person can apply to the Special Court for removal of attachment. I permit the petitioner to file an application before the concerned Special Court. The concerned Special Court will consider the same and give disposal on merits and in accordance with law within a period of sixteen weeks after such an application is filed.

4.With this liberty and direction, the writ petition is disposed of.
