PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Cr No.145/2022 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Section 174 (3) Cr.P.C., altered into u/s.306 IPC in Crime.No.145 of 2022, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner, who is the husband of the deceased, demanded a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- from the deceased father viz., defacto complainant herein for the medical expenses of his child. Upon the continuous demand, the deceased has committed suicide by hanging. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and his name has been falsely implicated in this case and he seeks anticipatory bail.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) would submit that the de facto complainant is the father-in-law of the petitioner and the co-accused have already been released on bail. He would further



submit that seven witness have been examined and the : ig witness are yet to be examined and hence, he strongly opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that seven witnesses have been examined and that the co-accused have already been released on bail, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi, Ramanathapuram District on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a)the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b)the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am until further orders.

(c)the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d)the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e)on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**; and;

(f)if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
