3. Recording this submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

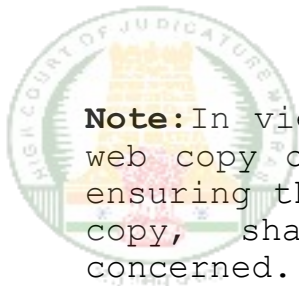
