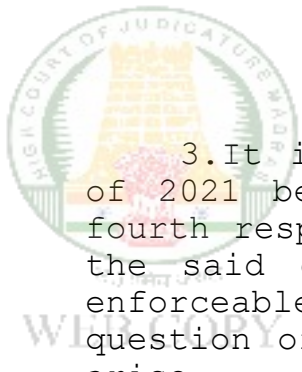

3.It is seen that the petitioner has already filed O.S.No.193 of 2021 before Sub Court, Manapparai in this regard against the fourth respondent herein. The petitioner has to necessarily pursue the said civil remedy. When the petitioner is not having any enforceable order or decree from the jurisdictional civil Court, the question of granting police protection in writ proceeding does not arise.

4.Leaving open the other remedies and rights of the petitioner, this writ petition is dismissed. No costs.
