4.In view of the above submission, this petition is allowed and the condition already imposed on the petitioner is fully relaxed.

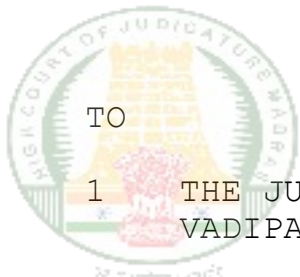
