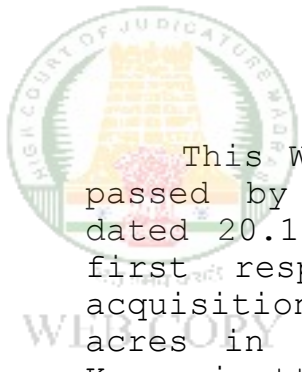

PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records of the second respondent in award No.2/2015/Kanavaipatti, dated 20.12.2015 in Roc.No.515/2013/A2, quash the same and consequently direct the first respondent to pass the award under the provisions of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 towards compensation for the acquisition of the lands owned by the petitioner measuring about 1.3 acres in Survey Nos.88/3, 90/4A, 90/4B etc.,in Vathalagundu and Kanavaipatti Villages, Nilakottai Taluk, Dindigul District.
