Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records pertaining to the impugned order in G.O.Ms.No.240 School Education Department dated 18.08.2010 on the file of the Respondent No.1 and quash the same as illegal to the extent of awarding first incentive increments for M.Com. (or) B.Ed. by treating both as one higher qualification instead of treating them as two separate higher qualifications for the Vocational Instructors for Commerce and Business (Accountability and Auditing) and quash the same as illegal and consequently to direct the respondents to provide second incentive increments to the petitioner for acquiring the additional qualification of B.Ed., within the time stipulated by this Court.
