ORDER

This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed by the mother of the detenu to produce the body of her son Rajkumar, who went missing from 13.07.2022 onwards.

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, submitted that based on the complaint given by the petitioner, a "man missing" FIR has been registered in Crime No.312 of 2022 by the third



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respondent Police and the investigation is pending. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor further submitted that all steps are being taken to find the whereabouts of the detenu.

3. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case, it will suffice if a direction is given to the third respondent police to follow the guidelines issued by this Court in ***K. Sukumari Vs. The Superintendent of Police, Virudhunagar District, Virudhunagar***, reported in **2018(2) - L.W. (Crl) - 636**. This Court expects the respondent police to expedite the investigation and find the whereabouts of the detenu as early as possible.

4. This Habeas Corpus Petition is disposed of accordingly.
