Criminal Miscellaneous Petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., to Extend the time limit for surrender before the Learned Special Court PCR Sivagangai by the order in CrI.O.P. (MD0.No.19158/2022 dt 14.11.2022 and thus render justice.
