Prayer in Crl.MP(MD) No.2583 of 2020 :

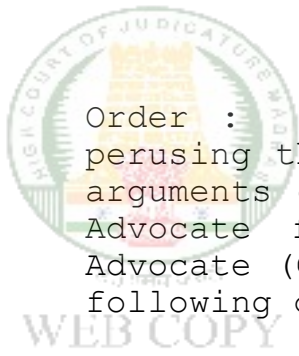
