Prayer in CRL MP(MD). No.13806 of 2022:-

This Petition filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, to extend period in the order dated 23.09.2022 made in Crl.OP(MD)No.16719 of 2022, on the file of this Honble Court.

Prayer in CRL OP(MD). 16719/ 2022 :

This Petition filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, to Direct the First Additional and Sessions Court for PCR Cases, Thanjavur to accept the petitioner surrender in connection with Crime No. 842 of 2022 on the file of the second respondent and consider her bail application on the same day in accordance with law.

ORDER:- This Petition coming on for orders on this day and upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. C. Senthil Murugan, Advocate for the Petitioner and of Mr. R. Suresh Kumar, Government Advocate for the respondents 1 & 2, this Court made the following order:

The learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the petition had been filed seeking extension of time to surrender before the Court of the learned I Additional and Sessions Judge for PCR Cases, Thanjavur.



2. Time to surrender the Petitioner before the learned I Additional and Sessions Judge for PCR Cases, Thanjavur, is extended for a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. However, this Court directs the learned I Additional and Sessions Judge for PCR Cases, Thanjavur, while considering the bail application of the Petitioner, the learned Sessions Judge shall take appropriate care as the defacto complainant is the staff of the Court concerned. While disposing of the case as the Petitioner apprehends that the defacto complainant would object to the petition. It is for the learned Sessions Judge to pass appropriate order considering the objection also, if any.

3. Accordingly, the Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is allowed.
