These petitions have been filed to modify the condition to the effect that the petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.1,000/- to the High Court Legal Services Authority, Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, Madurai instead of the petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- to the High Court Legal Services Authority, Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, Madurai and to extend the time granted in Crl.O.P(MD) No.18352 of 2022, dated 14.10.2022.



2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police.

Considering the reason stated in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, these petitions are allowed and the condition already imposed on the petitioner is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.1,000/- to the High Court Legal Services Authority, Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, Madurai and the time is extended for further two weeks for executing sureties, from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.
