2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, submitted that the detainee, Umadevi came before the respondent police and gave written statement to the effect that she married one Mohammed Riyas Kaja Mydeen and that she wants to live with him. However, the seven years old boy was handed over to the petitioner. The petitioner was also present before this Court along with his grandson.



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3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the said Umadevi had taken valuable jewelleryes and money along with her and the same should be secured.

4. In the considered view of this Court, the relief sought for by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner goes beyond the scope of this petition and the petitioner has to work out his remedy in the manner known to law.

5. This Habeas Corpus Petition is disposed of accordingly.
