PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.197 of 2022 on the file of
the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused No.2, who apprehends arrest at the hands
of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections
8(c) and 20(b)(ii)(B), 29(1) of NDPS Act, in Cr.No.197 of 2022,
seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and other
accused were found in illegal possession of 1.100 kg of Ganja.
Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that
based on the confession statement of the co-accused, the petitioner
has been arrayed as accused in this case and no recovery was made
from this petitioner. He would further submit that the petitioner is
innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the
prosecution. Therefore, he seeks anticipatory bail to the
petitioner.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that
the petitioner and his accused are involved in this case. The petitioner was



arrayed as A2. A1 was arrested and still in custody. A3 is still absconding. The quantity of Ganja involved in this case is 1.100 kg. The petitioner is having 1 previous case similar in nature. The investigation is not yet completed. Hence, he strongly opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

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5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the quantity of Ganja involved in this case is 1.100 kg, which is in between quantity, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Principal Special Court for EC & NDPS Act Court, Madurai, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Court concerned and on further conditions that:

(a) the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Special court/concerned court may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am until further orders.

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Special Court/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Special Court/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**; and;

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
