ORDER

The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the first respondent would submit that it is only an enquiry notice issued by the Revenue Divisional Officer, Melur Revenue Division, Madurai District in Na.Ka.No.3262/2021/C, dated 13.05.2022, directing the petitioner to appear before him on 27.05.2022 at 3.00 p.m. along with original documents. But the petitioner was not appeared for enquiry. However, the enquiry will be completed within a period of four weeks and the report will be submitted before this Court.
