The learned Judge shall consider the bail application of the Petitioner and dispose of the same as per law. The Special Court for Trial of Cases under SC/ST(Prevention of Atrocities) Act at Theni , shall cause notice to the De-Facto Complainant regarding the bail application when the bail application is filed.
