PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

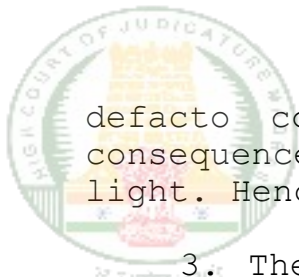
PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Cr No.403/2022 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/Accused No.1 to 4 & 6 to 8, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 147, 341, 294(b), 427 & 506(ii) of IPC, in Crime No.403 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to the land dispute between the parties, the accused persons gathered, abused the



defacto complainant with filthy language, threatened with severe consequences and damaged the defacto complainant's car indicator light. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent police submitted that there is no previous case pending against the petitioners and the petitioners have damaged the car indicator light.

5. Considering the nature of offence and the overt act attributed against the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners on conditions.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioners shall deposit a sum of **Rs.2,500/- (Rupees Two Thousand and Five Hundred only)** to the credit of Crime No.403 of 2022 before the concerned Court and on such deposit being made, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Trichy, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
