PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

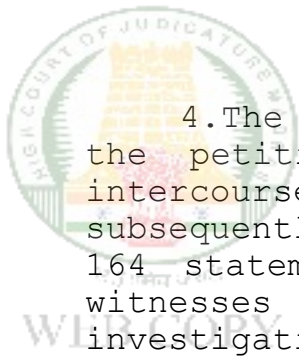
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 22 of 2022 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/accused, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 417, 376, 294(b) and 506(ii) IPC in Crime No.22 of 2022, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on promising to marry the de facto complainant, A1 had sexual intercourse with her and subsequently he refused to marry her. Hence the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit the petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and their names have been falsely implicated in this case and he seeks anticipatory bail.



4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) would submit at the petitioners herein are parents of A1 and A1 had sexual intercourse with the de facto complainant on promising to her and subsequently, refused to marry her. He would further submit that 164 statement of the de facto complainant was recorded and 10 witnesses have been examined. He further submitted that investigation of the case is pending and he strongly opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that 164 statement of the Victim was recorded and the 10 witnesses have been examined, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of their arrest or their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruchendur, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

a)the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b)the petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am until further orders;

(c)the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d)the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e)on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**; and;

(f)if the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
