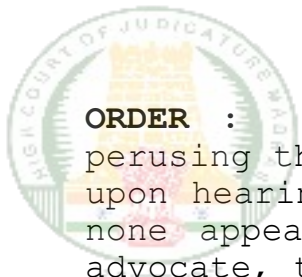

To issue a Writ of Mandamus, or any other appropriate Writ or Order or Direction in the nature of Writ directing the 1st respondent to instruct the 3rd respondent to make proper enquiry, regarding the pending salary of Rs. 23,80,000/- and considering the representation of the petitioner dated 25.08.2015.

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The present Writ Miscellaneous Petition has been filed to implead the fourth respondent in the said petition as a respondent in the main Writ Petition.

2. I have gone through the affidavit in the main Writ Petition. As per the averments made in the Writ affidavit, the petitioner had worked in Joint venture company, which was ventured into by the second and third respondents herein and they are liable to pay the arrears of salary of Rs.23,80,000/- to the writ petitioner. Accordingly, this writ petitioner has sought for a direction as against the first respondent herein to instruct the third respondent to conduct an enquiry and release the pending salary. Hence, the impleading application has no connection whatsoever with the main writ petition and the impleading petition is dismissed.
