2.The learned counsel for the petitioners as well as the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) would submit that after investigation, the respondent police has filed the final report as 'Mistake of Fact'.

3.In view of the same, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the amount of Rs.3,00,000/- which was deposited in crime No.19 of



2022. The learned Judicial Magistrate, Veda sandur, is directed to return the said amount of Rs.3,00,000/- to the petitioners without filing any formal petition.

4. With the above directions, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is disposed of.
