Considering the said submission, the condition imposed by this Court, in Crl.O.P.No.17248 of 2022 dated 27.09.2022, is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall report before **the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvaiyaru, on all working days at 10.30 a.m, for a period of 2 weeks and thereafter, appear on the date fixed by the learned Judicial Magistrate.**

5. With the above directions, this criminal miscellaneous petition is ordered.
