2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

It is seen from the records that the learned Magistrate in Crl.M.P.No.2548 of 2022 dated 04.07.2022 has directed the police to conduct reinvestigation and register an FIR if cognizable offence is made out and complete the investigation and thereafter file final report within a period of one month.
