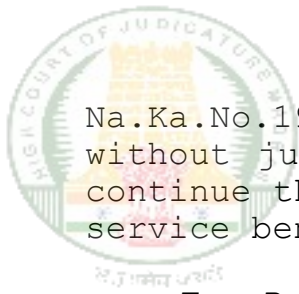
PRAYER: Contempt Petition is filed under Section 11 of the Contempt of Court Act, 1971, to summon first and second respondents in the above writ petition and punish them for their wilful disobedience of the order passed by this Court in W.M.P(MD).No.19219 of 2019 in W.P (MD).No.22433 of 2019 on 23.10.2019 and stay extension order dated 06.11.2019.

Prayer in WMP(MD). 19219/ 2019 :

Writ Miscellaneous Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to grant interim stay of the operation of the proceedings of the 1st respondent dt.14.9.2019 bearing reference No.R.No.53356/E4/S1/2019 dated 17.10.2019 bearing reference No.Na.Ka.No.1927/E/2019 pending disposal of the above WP and thus render justice.

Prayer in WP(MD). 22433/ 2019 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court for the issuance of Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, Calling for the records from the 1st respondent relating to proceedings dated 14.9.2019 bearing reference No.R.No.53356/E4/S1/2019 read with the proceedings of the 2nd respondent dated 17.10.2019 bearing reference No.



Na.Ka.No.1927/E/2019 and quash the same as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and to consequently direct the respondents to continue the petitioner in the office of the 2nd respondent with all service benefit.
