Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited relief sought for in the writ petition and without going into the merits of the case, there shall be a direction to the first respondent to act upon the representation made by the petitioner dated 04.11.2022 strictly in accordance with law and take a decision within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. The Writ Petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
