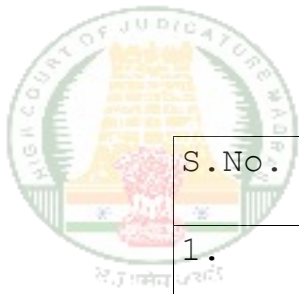
O R D E R

2.The case of the prosecution, as per the de-facto complainant, is that the petitioners have stolen the goats of the de-fact complainant on 23.09.2022. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned Counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely roped in this case.
