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ORDER

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner and the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the first respondent.

2. Considering the nature of the relief to be granted, issuance of notice to the second respondent is dispensed with.

3. The petitioner has suffered an order dated 23.02.2016 at the hands of the Tahsildar, Thirumangalam. Questioning the same, the petitioner filed an appeal before the first respondent.
