This Petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed in CrI.MP(MD)No.10372 of 2022 in CrI.O.P(MD).No.9477 of 2022, dated 01.09.2022.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been complying with the conditions regularly and hence, he seeks for relaxation of the condition.

3. The learned Government Advocate (CrI. Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the petitioner has been complying with the conditions.

4. Considering the said submissions and nature of offence, the condition imposed by this Court in CrI.MP(MD)No.10372 of 2022 in CrI.O.P(MD).No.9477 of 2022, is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall report before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Madurai, on all the hearing dates fixed by the concerned Magistrate/trial Judge, without fail.

5. With the above direction, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is ordered.

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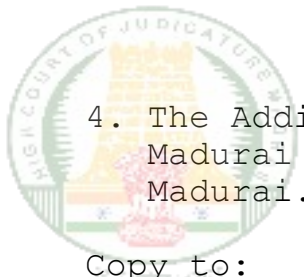
